### Background

As part of the global initiative, "Supporting decision-making and building capacity to support the Intergovernmental Platform on Biodiversity and Ecosystem Services (IPBES) through National Ecosystem Assessments", Azerbaijan embarked on a grand endeavour of national ecosystem assessment, a dedicated effort to develop a comprehensive synthesis of knowledge on biodiversity and ecosystem services to inform the country's future policymaking, planning and actions. The project began in 2019 and concluded in 2024. Financial support for the National Ecosystem Assessment of Azerbaijan was provided by the International Climate Initiative (IKI) of the German Federal Ministry for the Environment, Nature Conservation, Nuclear Safety, and Consumer Protection, with technical support from the National Ecosystem Assessment (NEA) Initiative at the UN Environment Programme World Conservation Monitoring Centre (UNEP-WCMC). The Azberbaijan National Ecosystem Assessment process was

implemented by the Regional Environmental Centre for the Caucasus (REC Caucasus) in coordination with the Ministry of Ecology and Natural Resources of Azerbaijan.

A <u>Summary for Policymakers Report</u> is an important outcome from the Azerbaijan National Ecosystem Assesement. This report draws on the Azerbaijan National Ecosystem Assesment Technical Report, highlighting key messages, important findings to form an essential knowledge ground for the management, use and conservation of biological diversity and ecosystem services. The national ecosystem assessment will support policy makers to improve existing ecosystem management policies and create grounds for management approaches. With the aim of facilitating exchange of experiences on key lessons learned, as well as provide an overview of the Azerbaijan National Ecosystem Assessment, a webinar is being organised to present main findings, lessons learned and challenges faced during the national ecosystem assessment process.

### **Objectives**

The webinar aims to bring a wide range of stakeholders together to:

- Provide an overview of the Azerbaijan National Ecosystem Assessment process, including main findings, policy recommendations and key lessons learned;
- Provide a platform to discuss the lessons learned and best practices from Azerbaijan that can be implemented in a national ecosystem assessment process;

### **Target Audience**

The target audience will include researchers, government representatives, policy makers, representatives of private sector, media, civil society organisations, and other experts from across the globe. The webinar is open to the general public, anyone with an interest in nature and biodiversity conservation.
